Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship

Award

\$200 per course per quarter, with total amount of award not to exceed \$3,000.

Application Information

To be considered for the Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship, an applicant must identify him/herself as a PTK member to his/her Kaplan University Admissions Advisor during the application process. No application form is required; however, membership in Phi Theta Kappa will be verified by Kaplan University prior to a scholarship award.

Requirements

- Must be a first-time enrollee in a bachelor’s degree program at Kaplan University; continuing students are not eligible.
- Must meet all current Kaplan University admissions requirements.
- Must be a verifiable member of Phi Theta Kappa International Honor Society of the Two-Year College at a previously attended institution of higher education.
- Must take a minimum of two courses per term and maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5.
- Must be continuously enrolled; withdrawing from school will result in ineligibility.

Specific Guidelines

If approved, the scholarship will be granted at the time of initial enrollment and credited at the rate of \$200 per course until the funds awarded have been depleted or the student loses eligibility. If a student fails and retakes a course, scholarship money will not be re-awarded for that course. This scholarship may be combined with the Kaplan University Accelerated Scholars Award.
